
The Calaveras Planning Coalition (CPC) is composed of community groups, organizations, and individuals interested in growth and planning issues in Calaveras County. The Coalition is united in its belief in the need for a comprehensive update to the Calaveras County General Plan. Further, the Coalition believes that citizen participation is the key to a successful update of the General Plan, and necessary to the update of area specific plans throughout the County.

As you know, the County and its consultants are preparing a background report to help inform the update of the Calaveras County General Plan. The CPC is providing the attached materials to assist the County and its consultants in preparing that background report.

The Government Code requires each County to prepare a comprehensive general plan. (Government Code, Section 65300.) There are seven mandatory elements: land use, circulation, housing, conservation, open space, noise, and safety. (Government Code, Section 65302.) "The degree of specificity and level of detail of the discussion of each such element shall reflect local conditions and circumstances." (Government Code, Section 65301, subd. (c).) In the documents that follow, we identify some of the local conditions and circumstances in Calaveras County that must be addressed in the general plan update.
